Village of Romeoville and the Will County Governmental League Electrical Aggregation Group Continues to Save Residents and Businesses Money on Electric Bill

In the Spring of 2012, the Village of Romeoville and several communities formed the Will County Governmental Electric Aggregation Group (WEAG) in an effort to reduce electrical supply costs for residents and small businesses.

Together the member communities signed a 24 month contract for 100% renewable energy and a fixed rate for electrical supply of 4.83 cents per kWh. Yesterday, the Illinois Power Authority filed its 2014 Summer Electricity Supply Rate, referencing the new Commonwealth Edison rate, beginning June 1st, 2014 at 7.596 cents/kWh. Residents and businesses who are members of the WEAG will not pay this rate, but will continue to receive the savings from the aggregation program.

"This joint effort has proved to be financially beneficial for residents and businesses of Romeoville that joined the program," said Mayor John Noak. Through the Will County Governmental League, the WEAG Program has already saved residents and small businesses collectively over \$17 million. In October 2014, the WEAG will negotiate for a new fixed rate contract with electrical suppliers.
