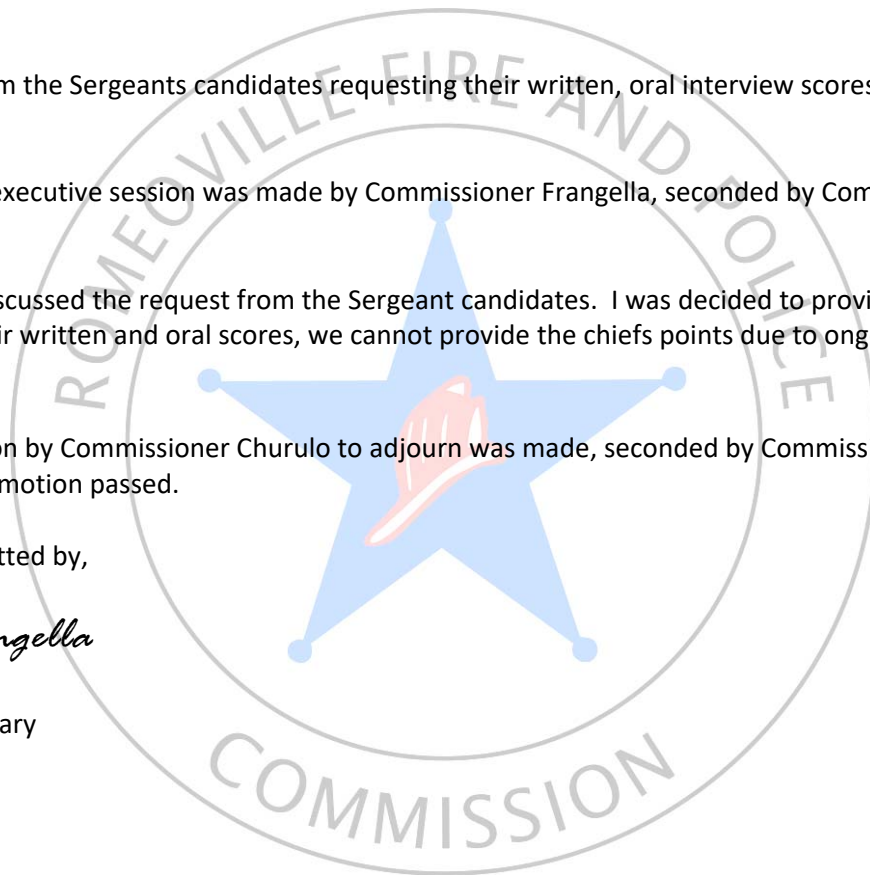
Adjournment:

Regular Meeting Minutes

August 6, 2019

Call to Order:

At 4:30 p.m. the regular meeting of the Board of Fire & Police Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Herbst. The meeting was held in Conference Room V119, Romeoville Village Hall, 1050 W. Romeo Road, Romeoville, Illinois.

Roll Call:

Upon roll call, the following were present: Chairman Thomas Herbst, Commission Secretary John Frangella, Commissioner Carl Churulo, Commissioner Gary Hoffman, Lourdes Aguirre, Chief Adams, Assistant Fire Chief Pemble, David Christiansen and Diana Herbst Clerical Assistant (via phone).

Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made by Commissioner Hoffman, seconded by Commissioner Churulo to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes for July 12, 2019. Upon roll call, ayes, Chairman Herbst, Commission Secretary Frangella, Commissioner Hoffman, and Commissioner Churulo. Voted on, all ayes. Motion approved.

Correspondence:

Received from Chief Turvey suspension for patrol officer.

Received a bill from PsychCare Associates for fire candidates Shaffer and Kehoe in amount of \$500.00.

Received a memo from Chief Turvey for patrol officer for failure to meet Chief reference uncompleted reports.

Received a memo from Steve Gulden, Village Manager, to move up the date for Fire/Paramedic testing dates.

Commissioner Frangella received an email from Assistant Fire Chief Pemble to review testing requirements at Edward Corporate Health. Commissioner Herbst will call them tomorrow about the physical agility testing to be eliminated.

Old Business:

Dave Christiansen took over the meeting to explain the testing scores and the procedure used and they can adjust the passing score test score from 70 (which gives 50% people passing) and if they lower the passing test score to 60 they would get 80% people pass. The oral test score will remain the same as before. The commissioners voted to use 60 as the passing score for the written, Commissioners voted on this, all ayes, motion passed.

The Commissioners decided to move the Fire/Paramedic orientation/written test to October 12, 2019 at Romeoville High School with 8:15 a.m. for sign in and 9 a.m. for orientation with written test to follow. The short applications will be available at the Fire Department Station One from 8-4 p.m. Monday thru Friday October 4, 2019. This will be posted on the Village web site on the Home Page and stating we are establishing list for current and future openings.

The Patrol short applications will be available at the Police Department from 8-8 p.m. Monday thru Friday with the deadline to turn in applications October 18, 2019. The sign in will be 8 a.m. at Romeoville High School with orientation to begin at 9 a.m. with written test to follow.

None of the police candidates that took the Sergeants test applied for preference points, so the list will remain the same.
