## What's Happening at Recreation?

The Village of Romeoville Parks and Recreation Department would like to thank Provena St. Joseph's Medical Center for their continued support of our Winter Wonderland Celebration.

As we head into spring we can look forward to enjoying many outdoor recreational opportunities. Currently Pacific Park, which is located in the Malibu Bay subdivision, is completed and ready for residents to use as soon as the weather permits. The construction of Fieldstone Park in the Fieldstone subdivision has begun and is anticipated for completion by the end of the summer 2009. We will also begin the construction of the Com-Ed Bike Trial Phase III in the spring. This link of the trail will begin at Sunset Park and run east to connect with Phase II which leads to Romeoville High School, giving children a safer route to school. The trail will also run west and connect with Pacific Park and Volunteer Park and end at the Com-Ed sub station on Weber Road.

The Village Board passed a resolution in November of 2008 for the Recreation Department to proceed with a 5 Year Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan project with Hitchcock Design Group. The scope of the plan will include; an Opportunity Analysis (needs assessment phase), Alternative Strategies (alternative strategy development phase) and the Final Master Plan (action plan development phase and final master plan preparation phase). Once this Master Plan is completed it will give the Recreation Department a guide and a vision of the desires and expectations of our residents. The Master Plan will also help the Recreation Department achieve its goals and help us to insure future funding resources.

Please take advantage of this guide that has resources for toddlers through high school.
