Romeoville's Lewis Airport added as an Appointment to the Joliet Regional Port District Board

On July 26, 2010 Gov. Quinn signed into law House Bill 6380, adding an additional appointment to the Joliet Regional Port District. The amendment, sponsored by State Representative Emily McAsey and Senator A.J. Wilhelmi, increased Board membership from 9 members to 10 members allowing Romeoville to have representation on the Board. "As the Lewis Airport continues to thrive, local representation is crucial," said State Representative McAsey.

The Lewis Airport is the only public reliever category airport located in Will County. The Joliet Regional Port District has been involved in assisting companies develop commercial activities within the 180 square miles in its 5 township jurisdiction since 1957. "As the Lewis Airport is located within the Village limits, this affords Romeoville the opportunity to have representation on a very important element of our community," said Mayor John Noak.

The Joliet Regional Port District assumed ownership of the Lewis University Airport on April 15, 1989.

"The airport continues to be a vital component of future economic development within the region," said State Senator A.J. Wilhelmi.

"Allowing a Romeoville representative on the Board will enhance local partnerships and encourage further development of the airport and surrounding areas."
