

WELCOME

The Village of Romeoville welcomes you to this Public Open House for the proposed 135th Street (a.k.a. Romeo Road) Federal-Aid roadway improvements from 600' east of Weber Road to IL RTE 53 in the Village of Romeoville.

The project is being planned and designed in coordination with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). We invite you to inspect the project exhibits on display at the meeting and visit with the personnel from the Village and the project consultant.

Your comments and opinions are important to us and we encourage you to provide them in writing or orally while in attendance. Written questions or comments should be directed to the Village and placed in the comment box, emailed or mailed to the address shown on the last page of this brochure. For your correspondence to become a part of the official record of this open house, it should be postmarked by **March 5, 2021**.

PURPOSE OF MEETING

To present:

- Proposed roadway improvements along 135th Street from 600' east of Weber Road to IL RTE 53
- Project schedule

To obtain from the public:

- Comments
- Concerns
- Suggestions

SCOPE OF WORK

- Convert to a Complete Street with the addition of on-road bike lanes
- A road diet reducing the number of travel lanes from 4 to 3
- New asphalt surface to improve drivability and new curb & gutter as needed to correct drainage imperfections
- Improve sidewalk and ramps to adhere to the American Disabilities Act
- Enhance pedestrian safety with Rectangular Rapid-Flashing Beacons at crosswalks
- Additional roadway signage for bicyclists

PROJECT SCHEDULE

This schedule is dependent upon project readiness (preparation of detailed contract plans) and the availability and obligation of construction funds thru the Will County Governmental League.

PHASE I: (2019-2021)

Preliminary Engineering & Environmental Studies

PHASE II: (2021-2022)

Final design with plans, specifications and estimates

PHASE III: (2023)

Construction

PROJECT GOALS


- Improve traffic flow
- Enhance traffic safety
- Improve the condition of the roadway pavement
- Connect nearby regional bike trails
- Improve adjacent sidewalk and ramps

OTHER FEATURES

- Resurfacing of the pavement within project limits
- Construction will be staged such that no detours will be required
